PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Professional development helps ensure the success of educational programs, improves the effectiveness of the school as well as individual staff members, and is required by state standards. Therefore, the District encourages and expects instructional staff, pupil personnel staff, and administrative staff to engage in professional development, including in-service training, graduate courses, and other appropriate activities.

The District recognizes its responsibility to promote professional development through planning, goal-setting, and budgetary commitment.

The Superintendent of Schools shall create and implement a Professional Development Plan to meet District goals and objectives.

School Board members are also encouraged to participate in activities to ensure they remain knowledgeable and current on educational issues that are relevant to the District.
